

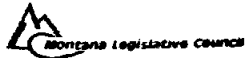

4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING A PERSON
5 RESIDING IN AN EXTENDED ZONING AREA OF A CITY OR TOWN TO
6 VOTE FOR THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OR TOWN."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9 NEW SECTION. **Section 1.** Participation in municipal
10 elections. If a city or town council or other legislative
11 body has extended the application of its zoning or
12 subdivision regulations beyond its boundaries, as provided
13 in 76-2-310, a person residing in the extended zoning area
14 who is qualified and registered to vote under state law may
15 vote in the elections for the governing body of the city or
16 town.
17 NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Codification instruction.
18 [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part
19 of Title 7, chapter 1, part 41, and the provisions of Title
20 7, chapter 1, part 41, apply to [section 1].
