Section 50-53-203, MCA, is amended to read: 12 "50-53-203. License fee and late fee -- disposition. 13 (1) (a) Except as provided in subsection (1)(b), each 14 15 application for an original or renewal license must be 16 accompanied by a license fee of \$75. 17 (b) The fee for an original or renewal license for a 18 public swimming pool or public bathing place operated in 19 conjunction with a public-accommodation campground, trailer 20 court, work camp, youth camp, hotel, motel, roominghouse, 21 boardinghouse, retirement home, or tourist home is \$50. 22 (2) An operator of a public swimming pool or public 23 bathing place who fails to renew a license by the expiration 24 date provided in 50-53-204 and who operates the public 25 swimming pool or public bathing place in the license year

for which no a renewal fee was not paid shall, upon renewal, pay to the department a late renewal fee of \$25 in addition to the renewal fee required by subsection (1). Payment of the late renewal fee does not relieve the operator of responsibility for any operation without a license.

6 (3) The department shall deposit 85% of the fees 7 collected under subsection (1) in the state special revenue 8 fund to the credit of the local board inspection fund 9 account created by 50-2-108. Money deposited in the local 10 board inspection fund account is subject to appropriation by 11 the legislature for the purposes of 50-53-218.

12 (4) The department shall deposit 15% of the fees 13 collected under subsection (1) and all the fees collected 14 under subsection (2) in an account in the state special 15 revenue fund to be appropriated by the legislature to the 16 department for the enforcement of 50-53-101 through 17 50-53-109 and this part."
