BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Establishment of individual

licensure. In consideration that the right to keep and bear arms is protected and reserved to the people in Article II, section 12, of the Montana constitution, every person who has not been convicted of a violent, felony crime and who is lawfully able to own or to possess a firearm under the Montana constitution is considered to be individually licensed and verified by the state of Montana within the meaning of individual licensure and verification in the federal Gun-Free School Zones Act of 1990.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction.

[Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 45, and the provisions of Title 45 apply to [section 1].
