BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 23-5-115, MCA, is amended to read:

12 *23-5-115. Powers and duties of department -13 licensing. (1) The department shall administer the
14 provisions of parts 1 through 6 of this chapter.

- (2) The department shall adopt rules to administer and implement parts 1 through 6 of this chapter.
- (3) The department shall provide licensing procedures, prescribe necessary application forms, and grant or deny license applications.
- (4) The department shall prescribe recordkeeping requirements for licensees, provide a procedure for inspection of records, provide a method for collection of taxes, and establish penalties for the delinquent reporting and payment of required taxes. If a rule or recordkeeping requirement requires the amount of money actually in a
