10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 **Section 1.** Section 7-15-4288, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "7-15-4288. Costs which that may be paid by tax
13 increment financing. The tax increments may be used by the
14 municipality to pay the following costs of or incurred in
15 connection with an urban renewal project or industrial
16 infrastructure development project:

- 17 (1) land acquisition;
18 (2) demolition and removal of structures;
19 (3) relocation of occupants;
20 (4) the acquisition, construction, and improvement of
21 infrastructure or industrial infrastructure, which includes
22 streets, roads, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, pedestrian malls,
23 alleys, parking lots and offstreet parking facilities,
24 sewers, sewer lines, sewage treatment facilities, storm
25 sewers, waterlines, waterways, water treatment facilities,

1 natural gas lines, electrical lines, telecommunications
2 lines, rail lines, rail spurs, bridges, publicly owned
3 buildings, and any public improvements authorized by parts
4 41 through 45 of chapter 12, parts 42 and 43 of chapter 13,
5 and part 47 of chapter 14 and items of personal property to
6 be used in connection with improvements for which the
7 foregoing costs may be incurred;

8 (5) costs incurred in connection with the redevelopment
9 activities allowed under 7-15-4233;

10 (6) acquisition of infrastructure-deficient areas or
11 portions thereof of areas;

12 (7) administrative costs associated with the management
13 of the industrial district;

14 (8) assemblage of land for development or redevelopment
15 by private enterprise or public agencies, including sale,
16 initial leasing, or retention by the municipality itself at
17 its fair value;

18 (9) the compilation and analysis of pertinent
19 information required to adequately determine the
20 infrastructure needs of secondary, value-adding industries
21 in the industrial district;

22 (10) the connection of the industrial district to
23 existing infrastructure outside the industrial district; and

24 (11) the provision of direct assistance, through
25 industrial infrastructure development projects, to

1 secondary, value-adding industries to assist in meeting
2 their infrastructure and land needs within the industrial
3 district; and

4 (12) the acquisition, construction, or improvement of
5 facilities or equipment for reducing, preventing, abating,
6 or eliminating pollution or for protecting the natural
7 environment."
