8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Filing of insurance claim for 9 10 patient. An emergency medical service that transports a 11 patient by ambulance shall determine whether and with whom 12 the patient has health insurance by making inquiries of the patient and, if necessary, the family, friends, or employer 13 14 of the patient. If a patient has health insurance, the 15 emergency medical service shall, on the patient's behalf, 16 file with the insurer a notice of claim and a claim form for 17 proof of loss that covers the emergency medical service's 18 bill for services provided the patient.

of Title 50, chapter 6, part 3, and the provisions of Title
