A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE TO FILE AN INSURANCE CLAIM ON BEHALF OF A TRANSPORTED PATIENT."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. **Section 1.** Filing of insurance claim for patient. An emergency medical service that transports a patient by ambulance shall determine whether and with whom the patient has health insurance by making inquiries of the patient and, if necessary, the family, friends, or employer of the patient. If a patient has health insurance, the emergency medical service shall, on the patient's behalf, file with the insurer a notice of claim and a claim form for proof of loss that covers the emergency medical service's bill for services provided the patient.

NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 50, chapter 6, part 3, and the provisions of Title 50, chapter 6, part 3, apply to [section 1].

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
