DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION: An act repealing the surcharge on retail sale of field rodenticides; amending and repealing existing statutes and providing an immediate effective date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. \$2,000 in the rodenticide account will be carried over and will expended in FY94. There will be no carry-over in FY95.
- 2. Department of Agriculture will receive up to \$5,000 in grant funds from rodenticide companies to conduct special field studies or research on control of field rodents with their rodenticide in FY95.
- 3. Current expenditure data is based on FY93 appropriated level.
