 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CLARIFYING THAT
 5 MUNICIPAL AND COUNTY RESOLUTIONS ARE IMMEDIATELY EFFECTIVE
 6 UNLESS THE RESOLUTION PROVIDES OTHERWISE; REDUCING FROM
 7 UNANIMOUS TO TWO-THIRDS THE VOTE REQUIRED TO ADOPT AN
 8 EMERGENCY ORDINANCE IN A MUNICIPAL COMMISSION-MANAGER FORM
 9 OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT; AMENDING SECTIONS 7-3-4325 AND
 10 7-5-4203, MCA; AND REPEALING SECTIONS 7-5-2201 AND 7-5-2202,
 11 MCA."

 13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

14 **Section 1.** Section 7-3-4325, MCA, is amended to read:

15 "7-3-4325. Effective date of ordinance or resolution.

16 (1) All ordinances and resolutions shall be in effect from
 17 and after are effective 30 days from after the date of their
 18 passage by the commission except as otherwise provided in
 19 this part or part 44.

20 (2) All resolutions are immediately effective unless a
 21 delayed effective date is specified in the resolution.

22 (2)(3) The commission may, by an affirmative vote of
 23 two-thirds of all the members, pass emergency measures to
 24 take effect at the time indicated therein in the measure."

25 **Section 2.** Section 7-5-4203, MCA, is amended to read:

1 "7-5-4203. Effective date of ordinances and
 2 resolutions. (1) No An ordinance or resolution passed by the
 3 council of any city or town may not become effective until
 4 30 days after its passage except:

5 (a) general appropriation ordinances providing for
 6 the ordinary and current expenses of the city or town; and
 7 (b) emergency measures.

8 (2) A resolution is immediately effective unless a
 9 delayed effective date is specified in the resolution."

10 **NEW SECTION. Section 3.** Repealer. Sections 7-5-2201
 11 and 7-5-2202, MCA, are repealed.
