"7-3-4325. Effective date of ordinance or resolution.

(1) All ordinances and-resolutions-shall-be-in-effect-from

and-after are effective 30 days from after the date of their

passage by the commission except as otherwise provided in

19 this part or part 44.

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(2) All resolutions are immediately effective unless a

delayed effective date is specified in the resolution.

(2)(3) The commission may, by an affirmative vote of

23 two-thirds of all the members, pass emergency measures to

24 take effect at the time indicated therein in the measure."

Section 2. Section 7-5-4203, MCA, is amended to read:

*7-5-4203. Effective 1 date of ordinances 2 resolutions. (1) No An ordinance or-resolution passed by the council of any city or town may not become effective until 30 days after its passage except: (1) (a) general appropriation ordinances providing for the ordinary and current expenses of the city or town; and (2)(b) emergency measures. (2) A resolution is immediately effective unless a delayed effective date is specified in the resolution." 10 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Repealer. Sections 7-5-2201 11 and 7-5-2202, MCA, are repealed.

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
