BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-32-4112, MCA, is amended to read:

*7-32-4112. Qualifications of policemen police officers. (1) The state of Montana determines that age is a valid and bona fide occupational qualification for the position of police officer because of the rigorous physical demands of the police profession and the expectation of many years of emergency service. The members of the police department on the active list of any city at the time of their appointment under this part may not be less than 18 years of age or more than 35 years of age, but this restriction does not apply to any-member--of--any--police department--as--of--July--27--19737--to-honorably-discharged persons-who-served-in-the-armed-forces-of-the-United--States in--time--of-wary-providing-such-time-of-service-is-not-less than-3-months;-or--to applicants for reinstatement under 7-32-4110.

(2) A police officer must be a citizen of the United
