DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act appropriating \$120,000 general fund for the Tumor Registry Act.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- DHES deleted the 1.50 FTE for the Tumor Registry Program as part of the lower priority reductions required in the 1. current level executive budget by Section 13 of HB2.
- DHES would restore the 1.50 FTE with this appropriation and would maintain services being provided in FY93 and 2. included in the executive budget for the Tumor Registry program.
- General fund included in HB2 for operations would not be duplicated, resulting in a net general fund increase of 3. \$82,988 for the 1995 biennium as a result of the proposed bill.
