An act revising fees for overweight vehicle permits effective January 1, 1994.

#### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. Projected number of overweight vehicle permits for a twelve month period is projected to be 13,420.
- 2. Current average overweight permit fee is estimated to be \$30.
- 3. Estimated average overweight permit fee under proposed legislation would be \$197.23.




