In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0574, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act continuing the existence of the appellate defender system, the appellate defender commission, and the office of the appellate defender.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The bill continues the existence of the Appellate Defender Commission and the Office of the Appellate Defender which was slated for termination on July 1, 1993. It is assumed that the office will remain administratively attached to the Department of Administration in accordance with current statute.
- 2. \$100,000 per year and 2.00 FTE were appropriated to fund the office and the commission during the 1993 biennium. It is assumed that a similar annual amount will be necessary to continue the functions.
- 3. Funding for the commission and office is provided from 7% of the 2% motor vehicle taxes (General Fund) which would otherwise be appropriated to the District Court Reimbursement Program in the Judiciary. The amounts expended for the commission and office reduce the funds available for district court reimbursement but have no net effect on the general fund.
