1 INTRODUCED BY BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A WORK-RELATED REPETITIVE MOTION INJURY IS COMPENSABLE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT RATHER THAN 7 THE OCCUPATIONAL DISEASE ACT OF MONTANA: AND AMENDING SECTIONS 39-71-119 AND 39-72-102, MCA." 9 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 11 Section 1. Section 39-71-119, MCA, is amended to read: 12 "39-71-119. Injury and accident defined. (1) "Injury" 13 or "injured" means: (a) internal or external physical harm to the body; 14 (b) damage to prosthetic devices or appliances, except 15 for damage to eyeglasses, contact lenses, dentures, or 16 hearing aids; or 17 18 (c) death. 19 (2) An Except as provided in subsection (6), an injury is caused by an accident. An accident is: 20 (a) an unexpected traumatic incident or unusual strain; 21 22 (b) identifiable by time and place of occurrence; 23 (c) identifiable by member or part of the body 24 affected; and (d) caused by a specific event on a single day or 25

- during a single work shift.
- (3) "Injury" or "injured" does not mean a physical or mental condition arising from:
- (a) emotional or mental stress; or
- (b) a nonphysical stimulus or activity.
- 6 (4) "Injury" or "injured" does not include a disease7 that is not caused by an accident.
- 8 (5) A cardiovascular, pulmonary, respiratory, or other
- 9 disease, cerebrovascular accident, or myocardial infarction
- 10 suffered by a worker is an injury only if the accident is
- 11 the primary cause of the physical harm in relation to other
- 12 factors contributing to the physical harm.
- 13 (6) Injury includes internal or external physical harm
- 14 to the body caused by repetitive motion performed in the
- 15 course and scope of employment over a period of time. A
- 16 repetitive motion injury is compensable under the provisions
- 17 of this chapter."
- Section 2. Section 39-72-102, MCA, is amended to read:
- 19 *39-72-102. Definitions. As used in this chapter,
- 20 unless the context requires otherwise, the following
- 21 definitions apply:
- 22 (1) "Beneficiary" is as defined in 39-71-116.
- 23 (2) "Child" is as defined in 39-71-116.
- 24 (3) "Department" means the department of labor and 25 industry.

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- 1 (4) "Disablement" means the event of becoming
 2 physically incapacitated by reason of an occupational
 3 disease from performing work in the worker's job pool.
 4 Silicosis, when complicated by active pulmonary
 5 tuberculosis, is presumed to be total disablement.
 6 "Disability", "total disability", and "totally disabled" are
 7 synonymous with "disablement", but they have no reference to
 8 "permanent partial disability".
- 9 (5) "Employee" is as defined in 39-71-118.

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- (6) "Employer" is as defined in 39-71-117.
- 11 (7) "Independent contractor" is as defined in 12 39-71-120.
 - (8) "Insurer" is as defined in 39-71-116.
 - (9) "Invalid" is as defined in 39-71-116.
 - (10) "Occupational disease" means harm, damage, or death as set forth in 39-71-119(1) arising out of or contracted in the course and scope of employment and, except as provided in 39-71-119(6), caused by events occurring on more than a single day or work shift. The term does not include a physical or mental condition arising from emotional or mental stress or from a nonphysical stimulus or activity.
 - (11) "Order" is as defined in 39-71-116.
- 23 (12) "Pneumoconiosis" means a chronic dust disease of
 24 the lungs arising out of employment in coal mines and
 25 includes anthracosis, coal workers' pneumoconiosis,

- silicosis, or anthracosilicosis arising out of such the
 mployment.
- 3 (13) "Silicosis" means a chronic disease of the lungs
- 4 caused by the prolonged inhalation of silicon dioxide (SiO)
- 5 and characterized by small discrete nodules of fibrous
- 6 tissue similarly disseminated throughout both lungs, causing
- 7 the characteristic x-ray pattern, and by other variable
- B clinical manifestations.
- 9 (14) "Wages" is as defined in 39-71-123.
- 10 (15) "Year" is as defined in 39-71-116."

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
