<u>DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:</u> An act creating a state housing task force; providing for the appointment of the members of the task force; providing for the powers and duties of the task force;

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The housing task force will be administratively attached to the Department of Administration.
- 2. The task force will be made up of 13 members appointed by the Governor including a member of the senate and the house, and a representative of the governor's office.
