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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Sale of real property that was site of crime or illness — immunity from liability. There is no cause of action against a seller or other transferor of real property, the seller's realtor or other agent, or the buyer's realtor or other agent for failure to disclose to the buyer that the real property was or may have been:

- (1) the site of a homicide or other felony or a suicide; or
- (2) occupied by a person infected with human immunodeficiency virus, acquired immune deficiency syndrome, or any other medical condition not known to be transmitted to humans merely through occupancy of real property.
- NEW SECTION. Section 2. Applicability. [This act]
 applies to causes of action arising after October 1, 1993.
