Section 1. Section 1-11-301, MCA, is amended to read:

*1-11-301. Publication and sale of Montana Code Annotated -- free distribution. (1) The legislative council with the advice of the code commissioner shall decide on the quantity, quality, style, format, and grade of all publications prior to having the code commissioner call for bids for the printing and binding and contract for their publication. The code commissioner shall follow the requirements of state law relating to contracts and bids, except as herein provided in this section.

(2) The methods of sale to the public of the MontanaCode Annotated and supplements or other subsequent and

ancillary publications thereto may be included as an alternative specification and bid and as a part of a contract to be let by bids by the code commissioner.

STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0646, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Increasing the allowable sale price of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA) to the cost plus 25 percent (25%); providing that sales to state and local government may be at cost plus 5 percent (5%).

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The 1995 biennium sales volume of MCA products by the Legislative Council will remain constant with the 1993 biennium sales.
- 2. Biennial revenue for the 1993 biennium is estimated at \$1,215,041.
- 3. The Legislative Council will use the authority provided in HB0646 in setting MCA product prices to generate approximately \$1,338,980 in revenue for the 1995 biennium. This amounts to about a 10% increase in total biennial MCA revenue over the 1993 biennium. The executive budget revenue estimate for the 1995 biennium is \$1,288,980.
- 4. The revenue impact is biennial and is shown in FY94 only, although a small percentage of the revenue is received in FY95.
- 5. All revenue and corresponding expenditures in the Legislative Council are in a state special revenue account.
- 6. The additional costs of purchase by state and local government agencies will be less than the 5% maximum markup allowed by the bill and is not considered material for individual agencies.

The additional costs to local governments for the purchase of the MCA will be less than 5% which will not have a material fiscal impact.

LONG-RANGE EFFECTS OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

The Legislative Council will continue to generate a profit of about 15.7% over the cost of producing the MCA.
