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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT INCREASING THE
MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE ON INDIAN AFFAIRS; AMENDING
SECTION 5-19-102, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE
DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 5-19-102, MCA, is amended to read:

"5-19-102. Committee on Indian affairs -- appointment
and composition. (1) There is a committee on Indian affairs.

(2) The committee consists of ~~two~~ four members of the
senate, appointed by the committee on committees on a
bipartisan basis, and ~~two~~ four members of the house of
representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house on a
bipartisan basis.

(3) Appointments must be made before final adjournment
of a regular session."

NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Effective date. [This act] is
effective on passage and approval.
