1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF

REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

- That the expenditure target for the general fund and school equalization aid for the ensuing biennium be
- 5 \$1,837,900,000.

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- 6 That additional revenue necessary to fund the 7 expenditure target for the ensuing biennium be \$99,000,000.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:
- 9 (1) That the Appropriations Committee be directed to
 10 submit to the House a budget for the general fund and school
 11 equalization aid account, including budget modifications and
 12 miscellaneous appropriations, that does not exceed the
 13 expenditure target;
- 14 (2) That the Taxation Committee be directed to submit a
 15 revenue package that will fund the expenditure target;
- 16 (3) That one-time revenue not be used for any purpose 17 other than creating an ending fund balance;
- 18 (4) That expenditures currently budgeted in the general
 19 fund not be funded with increased fee revenue in order to
 20 meet the expenditure target; and
- 21 (5) That temporary solutions to the state's chronic 22 fiscal woes not be used.
