BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 45-8-344, MCA, is amended to read:

"45-8-344. Use of firearms by children under fourteen prohibited -- exceptions. It is unlawful for a parent, guardian, or other person having charge or custody of a minor child under the age of 14 years to permit the minor child to carry or use in public any firearms of any description loaded with powder and lead, except when the child is accompanied by a person having charge or custody of the child or under the supervision of a qualified firearms safety instructor or other person who has been authorized by the parent or guardian."




