In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB0020, second reading.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act changing the name of a Vocational-Technical Center to a Technical Institute.

ASSUMPTIONS:Department of Transportation:

1. All existing highway "Vo-Tech Center" signs will be replaced by "Technical Institute" signs.
2. Sign size and placement will be the same as for existing "Vo-Tech Center" signs.
3. Only sign panels will be replaced, existing poles and mounting hardware will be reused wherever possible.
4. Twenty Eight sign panels will be replaced, sign size varies from 5 sq. ft. to 60 sq. ft.
5. Assume \$100 total cost to remove each existing sign panel and \$100 total cost to install each new sign panel.

Office of the Commissioner of Higher Education:

1. The name change would be phased in over the remainder of FY 93 and the first part of FY 94.
2. All existing consumable goods will be used up and then replaced in the normal course of business.
3. New course catalogs will be printed each year as a standard operating cost regardless of the name change.
4. Any fixtures displaying the old name will remain in place until such time as normal wear requires that they be replaced.



18 INSTALL NEW HIGHWAY ROAD SIGNS UNLESS THE LEGISLATURE
19 PROVIDES AN APPROPRIATION FOR THAT PURPOSE; AND

20 (2) A TECHNICAL INSTITUTE SHALL USE EXISTING STATIONERY
21 AND OTHER SUPPLIES TO MINIMIZE THE COST OF THE NAME CHANGE.
