4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ELIMINATING THE
5 REQUIREMENT THAT SCHOOL BOARD TRUSTEES HOLD MEETINGS IN
6 SCHOOL BUILDINGS OR BUILDINGS OWNED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT;
7 AMENDING SECTION 20-3-322, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE
8 EFFECTIVE DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 **Section 1.** Section 20-3-322, MCA, is amended to read:

12 **"20-3-322. Meetings and quorum.** (1) The trustees of a
13 district shall hold at least the following number of regular
14 meetings:

15 (a) an organization meeting, as prescribed by 20-3-321;

16 (b) a preliminary budget meeting, as prescribed by
17 20-9-113; and

18 (c) in first-class elementary districts, not less than
19 one regular meeting per month; or

20 (d) in any other district, regular meetings during the
21 months of April, July, October, and January.

22 (2) The trustees of the district shall adopt a policy
23 setting the day and time for the minimum number of regular
24 school meetings prescribed in subsection (1)(c) or (1)(d)
25 and, in addition, any other regular meeting days the

1 trustees wish to establish. ~~Except--for--an--unforeseen~~
2 ~~emergency,--meetings--must--be--conducted--in--school--buildings--or~~
3 ~~on--other--property--belonging--to--the--district--~~

4 (3) Special meetings of the trustees may be called by
5 the chairman presiding officer or any two members of the
6 trustees by giving each member a 48-hour written notice of
7 the meeting, except that the 48-hour notice is waived in an
8 unforeseen emergency.

9 (4) Business may not be transacted by the trustees of a
10 district unless it is transacted at a regular meeting or a
11 properly called special meeting. A quorum for any meeting is
12 a majority of the trustees' membership. All trustee meetings
13 must be public meetings, as prescribed by 2-3-201, except
14 that the trustees may recess to an executive session under
15 the provisions of 2-3-203.

16 (5) For the purposes of ~~subsections-(2)-and~~ subsection
17 (3), "unforeseen emergency" means a storm, fire, explosion,
18 community disaster, insurrection, act of God, or other
19 unforeseen destruction or impairment of school district
20 property that affects the health and safety of the trustees,
21 students, or district employees or the educational functions
22 of the district."

23 **NEW SECTION. Section 2.** Effective date. [This act] is
24 effective on passage and approval.
