SENATE BILL NO. 38

INTRODUCED BY AKLESTAD

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A BILL ASSESSING OR INCREASING A TAX OR FEE MAY PASS FROM THE HOUSE OF THE LEGISLATURE IN WHICH THE BILL WAS INTRODUCED ONLY BY A TWO-THIRDS OR GREATER VOTE OF THAT HOUSE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. **Section 1.** Limitation on revenue bills. A bill assessing a tax or fee or increasing an existing tax or fee may be passed from the house of the legislature in which the bill was introduced only by a two-thirds or greater vote of the members of that house.

NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 5, chapter 4, part 1, and the provisions of Title 5, chapter 4, part 1, apply to [section 1].
