6 FOR TEMPORARY OPERATING AUTHORITY FOR PROPORTIONALLY
7 REGISTERED VEHICLES; AMENDING SECTION 61-3-722, MCA; AND
8 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 **Section 1.** Section 61-3-722, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "61-3-722. Registration and identification of
13 proportionally registered vehicles -- effect of such
14 registration. (1) The department shall register ~~the vehicles~~
15 so-described each proportionally registered vehicle and
16 issue a license plate or plates, or a distinctive sticker,
17 or other suitable identification device, for each vehicle
18 described in the application upon payment of the appropriate
19 fees and property taxes, as provided by law, for the
20 application and for the license plates, stickers, or devices
21 issued. A fee of \$2 ~~shall~~ must be paid for each license
22 plate, sticker, or device issued for each proportionally
23 registered vehicle. A fee of \$5 must be paid for each
24 vehicle receiving temporary operating authority. A
25 registration card ~~shall~~ must be issued for each

1 proportionally registered vehicle. The registration card
2 ~~shall~~ must, in addition to other information required by
3 chapter 3, ~~bear--upon--its--face~~ show the number of the
4 license, sticker, or other device issued for the
5 proportionally registered vehicle and ~~shall~~ must be carried
6 in the vehicle at all times.

7 (2) Fleet vehicles ~~so~~ registered and identified ~~shall~~

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:


This bill would establish a fee paid for temporary operating authority for proportionally registered vehicles effective July 1, 1993.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Temporary operating authority is issued to 50 vehicles per day, at the current fee rate of \$2.00 per vehicle, for a total of \$100 per day. Temporary operating permits are issued approximately 200 working days per year.
2. The number of temporary operating authority requests would not decrease due to an increase of \$3.00 per vehicle.
3. The cost of processing a request would not change.

SB 110

APPROVED BY COMMITTEE
ON HIGHWAYS & TRANSPORTATION

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REGISTRATION PLAN OF THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATORS, ADOPTED APRIL 1988. A registration card ~~shall~~ must be issued for each proportionally registered vehicle. The registration card ~~shall~~ must, in addition to other information required by chapter 3, ~~bear-upon-its-face~~ show the number of the license, sticker, or other device issued for the proportionally registered vehicle and ~~shall~~ must be carried in the vehicle at all times.

(2) Fleet vehicles ~~so~~ registered and identified ~~shall~~ be--deemed as fleet vehicles are considered fully licensed and registered in this state for any type of movement or operation, except that, in those instances in which a grant of authority is required for intrastate movement or operation, the vehicle may not be operated in intrastate commerce in this state unless the owner has been granted intrastate authority by the public service commission and unless the vehicle is being operated in conformity with that authority."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 1993.

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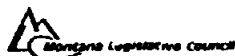
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
