

In accordance with the power vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, I hereby return Senate Bill 192, "AN ACT DIRECTING THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT BOARD TO MAXIMIZE THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS OF THE MEMBERS AND BENEFICIARIES OF EACH SYSTEM THAT THE BOARD ADMINISTERS REVIEW BENEFITS PAID BY THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND TO RECOMMEND COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS TO THE LEGISLATURE; AND AMENDING SECTION SECTIONS 19-3-304, 19-5-201, 19-6-201, 19-7-201, 19-8-201, 19-9-201, 19-12-210, AND 19-13-202, MCA," with the attached amendments.
