DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act removing the termination date of the wildlife habitat acquisition program.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There will be no fiscal impact in FY94 and FY95 since the program is not scheduled to terminate until March 1, 1996.

LONG-RANGE EFFECTS OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

The wildlife habitat acquisition program will continue at its current level of \$3 million per year.
