4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE  
5 PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT BOARD RATHER THAN THE  
6 DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION SHALL EMPLOY TECHNICAL OR  
7 ADMINISTRATIVE EMPLOYEES WHO ARE NECESSARY FOR THE  
8 TRANSACTION OF THE BUSINESS OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEMS  
9 ADMINISTERED BY THE BOARD; AND AMENDING SECTION 19-3-301,  
10 MCA."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13 **Section 1.** Section 19-3-301, MCA, is amended to read:

14 "19-3-301. Location of board -- quorum -- officers and  
15 employees. (1) The board shall maintain its office in the  
16 city of Helena.

17 (2) A quorum of the board shall be three members.

18 (3) The board shall elect one of its members president.

19 The board may appoint a committee of one or more of its  
20 members which shall have authority to perform routine acts  
21 such as retirement of members and fixing of retirement  
22 allowances, approval of death claims, and correction of  
23 records necessary in the administration of the system in  
24 accordance with the provisions of this chapter and rules of  
25 the board. The attorney general shall be the legal counsel

1 for the board.

2 (4) ~~The department of administration shall appoint and~~  
3 ~~fix the compensation of the administrator and other~~  
4 ~~necessary employees~~ board shall employ technical or  
5 administrative employees who are necessary for the  
6 transaction of the business of the retirement systems  
7 administered by the board."
