BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-12-201, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-12-201. Appointment of employees as peace officers. The director of transportation may appoint employees of the department as peace officers to carry out this part. The employees appointed may include only those employees of the department who are employed in the administration of the gross-vehicle-weight motor carrier services functions of the department and employees of another state or province.

Out-of-state personnel may be appointed only for the purpose of enforcement of gross vehicle weight statutes at joint weigh station facilities. Each employee appointed shall must be issued a certificate of appointment and execute an oath of office which-shall that must be entered into the records of the department."
