6 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CREATING A LUMP-SUM  
7 APPROPRIATION TO BE ALLOCATED BY THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF  
8 HIGHER EDUCATION TO THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM UNITS; AND  
9 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND AN APPLICABILITY DATE."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Lump-sum appropriation for  
13 higher education. (1) Any money appropriated in the general  
14 appropriations act for university system units, as defined  
15 in 17-7-102, must be considered a single appropriation to  
16 the board of regents of higher education. Any specific  
17 allocation of funds contained in the appropriations act must  
18 be considered advisory only.

19 (2) The appropriation must be allocated by the board of  
20 regents pursuant to the operating budgets adopted in  
21 accordance with 17-7-138, 20-15-309, and 20-16-202.

22 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction.  
23 [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part  
24 of Title 17, chapter 7, and the provisions of Title 17,  
25 chapter 7, apply to [section 1].

1 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date --  
2 applicability. [This act] is effective July 1, 1993, and is  
3 applicable to the appropriations for higher education in the  
4 general appropriations act for the biennium beginning July  
5 1, 1993.
