17	evidence to the department as required by 16-4-101, shall
18	must be licensed by the department, in accordance with the
19	provisions of this code and such rules as-may-be prescribed
20	by the department, to:
21	(a) sell and deliver beer from its storage depot or
22	brewery located in Montana to:
