9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 **Section 1.** Section 90-5-101, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "90-5-101. Definition of terms. As used in this part,
12 unless the context otherwise requires, the following
13 definitions apply:

14 (1) "Agricultural enterprises" include but are not
15 limited to producing, warehousing, storing, fattening,
16 treating, handling, distributing, or selling farm products
17 or livestock.

18 (2) "Bonds" means bonds, refunding bonds, notes, or
19 other obligations issued by a municipality or county under
20 the authority of this part, including without limitation
21 short-term bonds or notes issued in anticipation of the
22 issuance of long-term bonds or notes.

23 (3) "Governing body" means the board or body in which
24 the general legislative powers of the municipality or county
25 are vested.

1 (4) "Higher education facilities" means any real or
2 personal properties required or useful for the operation of
3 an institution of higher education.

4 (5) "Institution of higher education" means any private
5 nonprofit corporation or institution within the state of
6 Montana:

7 (a) authorized to provide or operate educational
8 facilities; and

9 (b) providing a program of education beyond the high
10 school level.

11 (6) "Mortgage" means a mortgage or deed of trust or
12 other security device.

13 (7) "Municipality" means any incorporated city or town
14 in the state.

15 (8) "Project" means any land; any building or other
16 improvement; and any other real or personal properties
17 deemed considered necessary in connection therewith with the
18 improvement, whether or not now in existence, which ~~shall~~
19 must be suitable for use for commercial, manufacturing,
20 agricultural, or industrial enterprises; recreation or
21 tourist facilities; local, state, and federal governmental
22 facilities; multifamily housing, hospitals, long-term care
23 facilities, developmentally disabled treatment facilities,
24 or medical facilities; higher education facilities;
25 small-scale hydroelectric production facilities with a

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 90-5-101, MCA, is amended to read:

"90-5-101. Definition of terms. As used in this part, unless the context otherwise requires, the following definitions apply:

(1) "Agricultural enterprises" include but are not limited to producing, warehousing, storing, fattening, treating, handling, distributing, or selling farm products or livestock.

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(3) "Governing body" means the board or body in which the general legislative powers of the municipality or county are vested.

(4) "Higher education facilities" means any real or personal properties required or useful for the operation of an institution of higher education.

(5) "Institution of higher education" means any private nonprofit corporation or institution within the state of Montana:

(a) authorized to provide or operate educational facilities; and
