NEW SECTION. Section 1. Immunity. 13 (1)The state building codes bureau and local jurisdictions enforcing any 14 15 building code provisions and their employees are immune from 16 suit with respect to the administration and enforcement of the state or local building codes unless the agency involved 17 18 has actual knowledge of a building code violation that 19 constitutes an imminent threat to the safety, health, or 20 welfare of any person or property and does not make a 21 reasonable effort to enforce a correction of the violation 22 within a reasonable time of learning of the violation.

(2) Two or more building code enforcement jurisdictions
may jointly employ a building inspector or code enforcement
employee. In joint employment situations, all jurisdictions,

other than the jurisdiction in which a cause of action
accrues, have immunity with respect to the administration
and enforcement of the state or local building codes.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. 4 [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part 5 of Title 50, chapter 60, part 2, and the provisions of Title 6 50, chapter 60, part 2, apply to [section 1]. 7 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Two-thirds vote required. 8 Because (section 1) provides governmental immunity, Article 9 II, section 18, of the Montana constitution requires a vote 10

- 11 of two-thirds of the members of each house of the
- 12 legislature for passage.
