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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING THE BOARD OF
REGENTS OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO SUBMIT TO THE BUDGET DIRECTOR
ANNUAL CONTINGENCY BUDGETS BASED ON POSSIBLE REDUCTIONS IN
GENERAL FUND SPENDING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Contingency budgets for proposed reductions in spending. (1) Whenever a reduction in general fund spending may occur under the provisions of 17-7-140, the budget director shall notify the board of regents of higher education of the possibility of a reduction in spending.

- (2) By July 1 of each fiscal year, the board of regents of higher education shall submit to the budget director contingency budgets based on the following levels of reduction in general fund spending:
- (a) a contingency budget for up to a 10% general fund reduction in the budget of each agency or unit of higher education if the budget director notifies the board of regents 15 months prior to the fiscal year in which the spending reduction is to occur;
 - (b) a contingency budget for up to an 8% general fund
