5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT SUBMITTING TO THE
6 QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA THE QUESTION OF WHETHER OR NOT
7 THE LAW IMPOSING A STATEWIDE SALES TAX AND USE TAX AND
8 PROVIDING COMPREHENSIVE TAX REFORM SHOULD REMAIN IN EFFECT;
9 PROVIDING THAT THE QUESTION BE SUBMITTED TO THE QUALIFIED
10 ELECTORS AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 2,
11 1994; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

14 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Repealer. Chapter ____, Laws
15 of 1993 [Senate Bill No. 235], is repealed.

16 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Submission to electorate. The
17 question of whether Chapter ____, Laws of 1993 [Senate Bill
18 No. 235], which imposes a statewide sales tax and use tax
19 and provides comprehensive tax reform, shall remain in
20 effect shall be submitted to the qualified electors of
21 Montana at the general election to be held in November 1994
22 by printing on the ballot the full title of this act and the
23 following:

1 reform, including the enactment of a 4% sales tax
2 and use tax.

5 reform, including the enactment of a 4% sales tax
6 and use tax.

7 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. Section 1 is
8 effective on approval by the electorate.
