17 later than June 15 to renew the camper decal. If the vehicle
18 to which the camper is customarily attached may be
19 reregistered by mail, application for the camper decals may
20 also be made by mail in the manner provided in 61-3-535.

21 (2) The owner of a camper with a decal is entitled to
22 operate the camper between May 1 and June 15 without
23 displaying the decal for the current registration year if

25 decal from the previous registration year."

1 **NEW SECTION. Section 2.** Applicability. The effective
2 date applies to renewals on or after January 1, 1994. The

6 decal from the previous registration year.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act changing the date for annual application for camper decals to be consistent with that of motor homes and travel trailers.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The bill will have no fiscal impact on the Department of Justice.
2. The bill will have no fiscal impact on local governments. Full registration years must be paid regardless of the change in registration expirations and grace periods.

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CHANGING THE DATE FOR ANNUAL APPLICATION FOR CAMPER DECALS TO BE CONSISTENT WITH THAT OF MOTOR HOMES AND TRAVEL TRAILERS; AMENDING SECTION 61-3-525, MCA; AND PROVIDING A DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE AND AN APPLICABILITY DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-3-525, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-3-525. Annual application for decals. (1) Camper decals expire annually on April 30. Application may for registration must be made to the county treasurer for the issuance of camper decals annually when the motor vehicle to which the camper is customarily attached is registered not later than June 15 to renew the camper decal. If the vehicle to which the camper is customarily attached may be reregistered by mail, application for the camper decals may also be made by mail in the manner provided in 61-3-535.

(2) The owner of a camper with a decal is entitled to operate the camper between May 1 and June 15 without displaying the decal for the current registration year if the owner, during that period, displays upon the camper the decal from the previous registration year."

NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Applicability. The effective date applies to renewals on or after January 1, 1994. The owner of a camper with a decal that expires between January 1, 1994, and June 15, 1994, may operate the camper if the owner, during that period, displays upon the camper the decal from the previous registration year.

NEW SECTION. **Section 3.** Effective date. [This act] is effective January 1, 1994.
