BY REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING MOTORCYCLISTS
OF ALL AGES TO WEAR PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR; AMENDING SECTION
61-9-417, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-9-417, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-9-417. Headgear required for minor motorcycle
riders. An operator and passenger under-18-years-of--age of
any motorcycle or quadricycle operated upon the streets or
highways of this state shall wear protective headgear upon
the head. The headgear shall must meet standards established
by the department of justice."
