4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING THE
6 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES TO STUDY THE
7 HEALTH RISKS OF DENTAL FILLINGS.

9 WHEREAS, it is a common practice in Montana to use an 10 amalgam of materials for dental fillings; and

11 WHEREAS, the dental amalgam is often thought by the 12 public to be silver and is actually a combination of silver, 13 copper, tin, and mercury; and

WHEREAS, some studies allege that toxic mercury vapors can leak from fillings into the blood system and cause serious health problems, particularly in persons with allergies or chemical sensitivities; and

WHEREAS, dental patients often lack information that would enable them to avoid having mercury used for their fillings.
