4    A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF  
5    REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA URGING THE  
6    DEPARTMENT OF STATE LANDS TO DEVELOP VOLUNTARY WILDLIFE  
7    HABITAT MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF ALL MONTANA  
8    FORESTRY PRACTICES.

10       WHEREAS, Chapter 608, Laws of 1991, created streamside  
11    management zones in order to maintain the integrity of  
12    forest streams; and  
13       WHEREAS, one purpose of the law was to provide voluntary  
14    guidelines for the management of wildlife habitat within  
15    streamside management zones; and  
16       WHEREAS, subsequent development of the guidelines  
17    identified the need to apply wildlife management practices  
18    beyond the streamside management zones; and  
19       WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to encourage  
20    timber harvest that is generally compatible with wildlife  
21    and wildlife habitat.

23    NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE  
24    OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
25       That the Department of State Lands be urged to develop

1    voluntary wildlife habitat management guidelines for the  
2    conduct of all forestry practices in Montana.

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
