CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

HOUSE BILL NO. 24

INTRODUCED BY WANZENRIED

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE XII, SECTION 1, OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE LEGISLATURE PROVIDE FOR A DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Article XII, section 1, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read:

"Section 1. Agriculture Special levies and assessments.

~~{1}--The--legislature--shall--provide--for--a--Department--of Agriculture--and--enact--laws--and--provide--appropriations--to protect,--enhance,--and--develop--all--agriculture--~~

{2} Special levies may be made on livestock and on agricultural commodities for disease control and indemnification, predator control, and livestock and commodity inspection, protection, research, and promotion. Revenue derived shall be used solely for the purposes of the levies."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Submission to electorate. This amendment shall be submitted to the qualified electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 1994

by printing on the ballot the full title of this act and the following:

- ☐ FOR removing the requirement that the legislature provide for a department of agriculture.
