CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

1 House BILL NO. 25  
2 INTRODUCED BY WANTZENRIED  
3  
4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT SUBMITTING TO THE  
5 QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE XII,  
6 SECTION 2, OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION TO REMOVE THE  
7 REQUIREMENT THAT THE LEGISLATURE PROVIDE FOR A DEPARTMENT OF  
8 LABOR AND INDUSTRY."  
9  
10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
11 **Section 1.** Article XII, section 2, of The Constitution  
12 of the State of Montana is amended to read:  
13 "Section 2. ~~labor Regular workday. {1}--The-legislature~~  
14 ~~shall-provide-for-a-Department-of-labor-and-industry, headed~~  
15 ~~by-a-commissioner-appointed-by-the-governor-and-confirmed-by~~  
16 ~~the-senator~~  
17 {2}--A maximum period of 8 hours is a regular day's work  
18 in all industries and employment except agriculture and  
19 stock raising. The legislature may change this maximum  
20 period to promote the general welfare."  
21 NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Submission to electorate. This  
22 amendment shall be submitted to the qualified electors of  
23 Montana at the general election to be held in November 1994  
24 by printing on the ballot the full title of this act and the  
25 following:
