In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB0003, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION: An act eliminating silicosis benefits.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. There are 18 silicotics remaining and 82 silicotic beneficiaries or spouses of claimants who died prior to March 14, 1974, who are receiving \$200 a month in benefits.
- 2. The are 63 survivors/beneficiaries of claimants who died after March 14, 1974, who are receiving \$100 a month.
- 3. Benefits will cease March 31, 1994, providing a three-month transition period.
- 4. The general fund savings for FY94 will be \$73,102 based on the current number of projected claimants/beneficiaries.
- 5. Funding for this program is 100 percent general fund appropriated in HB2.
