

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION: Increases filing fees for candidates for the legislature.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The current filing fee is \$15. The new fee will be \$50. Assuming 288 candidates file for legislative offices in FY94, the increased general fund revenue will be \$10,080 (288 x \$35).




