In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB0007, as introduced.

<u>DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION</u>: Reduces the number of county election administrator workshops conducted by the Secretary of State's Office from one per year to one every two years.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The Secretary of State's Office will not hold the annual county election administrator workshop in even-numbered years (FY94, FY96, etc.). This is estimated to reduce general fund expenditures, primarily for travel reimbursement for the county administrators, by \$5,000 in FY94 and even-numbered fiscal years thereafter.
