10	Section 1. Section 7-32-4112, MCA, is amended to read:
11	<b>7-32-4112. Qualifications of <del>policemen</del> police officers</b> . The state of Montana determines that age
12	is a bona fide occupational qualification for the position of police officer because of the rigorous physical
13	demands of the profession and the expectation of many years of emergency service. (1) The members $\underline{A}$
14	member of the a police department on the active list of any city at the time of their appointment under this
15	part <u>:</u>
16	(1) may not be less than 18 years of age or more than 35 years of age, but this restriction does
17	not apply to any except:
18	(a) for a member of any police department as of July 2, 1973 <del>, to</del> ;
19	(b) an honorably discharged <del>persons</del> <u>person</u> who served <u>3 months or more</u> in the armed forces of
20	the United States in time of war <del>, providing such time of service is not less than 3 monthe,</del> ; or
21	(c) to applicants an applicant for reinstatement under 7-32-4110-;
22	(2) A police officer must be a citizen of the United States; and
23	(3) shall meet the minimum qualifying standards for employment promulgated by the board of crime
24	control."
