DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act authorizing the issuance of personalized veterans' license plates.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- Currently, there are 9,200 veterans' license plates issued. Of those, it is
 estimated that 750 will convert to personalized veteran license plates during FY96,
 and an additional 250 during FY97.
- 2. About 100 veterans per year who currently purchase regular license plates will now switch to a personalized veterans' plate.
- 3. The current personalized plate fees are: original application \$20 to the general fund and \$5 to the county; renewal application \$5 to the general fund and \$5 to the county. It is assumed these fees will remain as established by 61-3-406, MCA.
- 4. Veterans/purple heart fees for original and renewal license plates and revenue distributions remain as established by 61-3-332 (10)(f)(iii): original application \$1 to the general fund, \$3 to the county, and \$6 to the veterans' cemetery state special revenue account; renewal application \$10 to the veterans' cemetery.
