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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	Section 1. Section 2-15-3303, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"2-15-3303. Board of oil and gas conservation composition allocation quasi-judicial. (1)
12	There is a board of oil and gas conservation.
13	(2) The board consists of seven members, three of whom <del>shall</del> <u>must</u> be from the oil and gas
14	industry and have had at least 3 years' experience in the production of oil and gas and two of whom shall
15	must be landowners residing in oil or gas producing counties of the state but not actively associated with
16	the oil and gas industry <del>, but one <u>One</u> of the two landowners <del>shall</del> <u>must</u> <del>be one who owns the</del> <u>own</u> mineral</del>
17	rights with the surface, and the other <del>shall be one who does</del> <u>may</u> not own <del>the</del> mineral rights.
18	(3) The board is allocated to the department for administrative purposes only as prescribed in
19	2-15-121. However, the board may hire its own personnel, and 2-15-121(2)(d) does not apply. The board
20	may also prescribe the duties and annual salary of four professional staff-positions.
21	(4) The board is designated as a quasi-judicial board for purposes of 2-15-124."
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23	Section 2. Section 2-18-103, MCA, is amended to read:
24	"2-18-103. Officers and employees excepted. Parts 1 and 2 do not apply to the following positions
25	in state government:
26	(1) elected officials;
27	(2) county assessors and their chief deputy;
28	(3) officers and employees of the legislative branch;
29	(4) judges and employees of the judicial branch;
30	(5) members of boards and commissions appointed by the governor, the legislature, or other



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1	elected state officials;
2	(6) officers or members of the militia;
3	(7) agency heads appointed by the governor;
4	(8) academic and professional administrative personnel with individual contracts under the authority
5	of the board of regents of higher education;
6	(9) academic and professional administrative personnel and live-in houseparents who have entered
7	into individual contracts with the state school for the deaf and blind under the authority of the state board
8	of public education;
9	(10) teachers under the authority of the department of corrections and human services or family
10	services;
11	(11) investment officer, assistant investment officer, executive director, and three professional staff
12	positions of the board of investments;
13	(12) four professional staff positions under the board of oil and gas conservation;
14	(13)(12) assistant director for security of the Montana state lottery;
15	(14)(13) executive director and senior investment officer of the Montana board of science and
16	technology development;
17	(15)(14) executive director and employees of the state compensation insurance fund;
18	<del>(16)</del> (15) state racing stewards employed by the executive secretary of the Montana board of
19	horseracing;
20	(17)(16) executive director of the Montana wheat and barley committee; and
21	(18)(17) commissioner of banking and financial institutions."
