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15	Section 1. Section 37-17-302, MCA, is amended to read:
16	"37-17-302. Application qualifications. (1) Application for examination for licensing licensure
17	as a psychologist shall must be made on forms prescribed by the board.
18	(2) The board shall license as a psychologist any person who pays the prescribed fee, passes the
19	prescribed examination, and submits evidence by oath that he the person:
20	(a) is a resident of or shows satisfactory evidence of intent to become a resident of this state at
21	the time he is licensed;
22	(b) is at least 18 years of age <u>or older;</u>
23	(a) (b) is of good moral character;
24	(d) (c) (i) has received a doctoral degree in clinical psychology from an accredited college or
25	university having an appropriate graduate program approved by the American psychological association;
26	(ii) has received a doctoral degree in psychology from an accredited college or university not
27	approved by the American psychological association and has successfully completed a formal graduate
28	retraining program in clinical psychology approved by the American psychological association; or
29	(iii) has received a doctoral degree in psychology from an accredited college or university, and
30	whese has completed a course of studies that meets minimum standards specified in rules by the board;

2	(a) (d) has completed at the time of application a minimum of 2 years of supervised experience in
3	the practice , research, or teaching of psychology. One year of this experience shall <u>must</u> be postdoctoral
4	but may not include more than 6 months of supervised research, teaching, or a combination of both."
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6	Section 2. Section 37-17-304, MCA, is amended to read:
7	"37-17-304. Admission of licensees from other states or jurisdictions. A license without written
8	examination may be issued to a psychologist licensed or certified in another state where the licensing or
9	certification requirements are substantially equivalent to the requirements of this chapter or to a
10	psychologist who is a diplomate in good standing of the American board of professional psychology or
11	Canadian jurisdiction upon meeting criteria or entering into an agreement established by the board."
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13	Section 3. Section 37-17-308, MCA, is amended to read:
14	"37-17-308. Department to publish list of licensees. The department shall publish yearly a list of
15	psychologists licensed under this chapter. This list shall must contain names, and addresses, and other
16	information the board considers advisable. The department shall mail a copy of this list to each person
17	licensed under this chapter, place a copy on file in the secretary of state's office, and furnish copies to the
18	public on request ."
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20	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Foreign-trained applicants. The transcripts of a foreign-trained
21	applicant for licensure as a psychologist must be evaluated by a board-approved agency that reviews
22	credentials. Upon receipt of this evaluation, the board shall determine whether the number of academic
23	credits awarded and academic areas studied meets equivalent educational standards for a doctoral degree
24	in clinical psychology established by a graduate program approved by the American psychological
25	association.
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27	NEW SECTION. Section 5. Licensure of senior psychologists. The board may issue a senior
28	psychologist's license to an applicant who:


