5	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PLACING THE FORENSIC FACILITY AT WARM SPRINGS,
6	MONTANA, UNDER THE ADULT CORRECTIONS COMPONENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS
7	AND HUMAN SERVICES; AMENDING SECTION 53-1-202, MCA; AND PROVIDING A CONTINGENT
8	EFFECTIVE DATE."

10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	Section 1. Section 53-1-202, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"53-1-202. Department of corrections and human services. (1) The following components are
14	included in the department of corrections and human services to carry out the purposes of the department:
15	(a) adult corrections services consisting of the following institutional components to incarcerate
16	and rehabilitate felons pursuant to Title 46, chapter 18:
17	(i) <u>the</u> Montana state prison;
18	(ii) the Montana women's correctional center; and
19	(iii) the forensic unit at Warm Springs; and
20	(iii)(iv) appropriate community-based programs for the placement, supervision, and rehabilitation of
21	adult felons who meet the criteria developed by the department for placement:
22	(A) in prerelease centers;
23	(B) under intensive supervision;
24	(C) under parole or probation pursuant to Title 46, chapter 23, part 2; or
25	(D) in other appropriate programs;
26	(b) mental health services consisting of the following institutional components for care and
27	treatment of the mentally ill pursuant to Title 53, chapter 21:
28	(i) <u>the</u> Montana state hospital;
29	(ii) <u>the</u> Montana center for the aged; and
30	(iii) a community services component consisting of appropriate services for the care and treatment



1 of the mentally ill pursuant to Title 53, chapter 21, part 2; 2 (c) chemical dependency services consisting of appropriate detoxification, inpatient, intensive 3 outpatient, outpatient, prevention, education, and other necessary chemical dependency services pursuant 4 to Title 53, chapter 24; 5 (d) institutional and residential components of the developmental disabilities system for those 6 developmentally disabled persons who require that care according to Title 53, chapter 20, consisting of: 7 (i) the Montana developmental center; and 8 (ii) the Eastmont human services center; and 9 (e) veterans' nursing homes for the nursing home and domiciliary care of honorably discharged 10 veterans as provided by law, consisting of: 11 (i) the Montana veterans' home; and 12 (ii) the eastern Montana veterans' home at Glendive. 13 (2) A state institution may not be moved, discontinued, or abandoned without prior consent of the 14 legislature." 15 16 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective 20 days after the governor, by 17 executive order, declares that the construction of the new forensic unit at the Montana state hospital 18 complex in Warm Springs, Montana, is complete. 19 -END-

Fiscal Note for HB0187, as introduced

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

A bill placing the forensic facility at Warm Springs Montana under the adult corrections component of the Department of Corrections and Human Services.

ASSUMPTIONS :

1. The current forensic unit will not be used as a prison reception unit until proposed renovations are completed at Montana State Hospital. There will be no fiscal impact during the 1997 biennium.

FISCAL IMPACT:
