15	(b) the address of the business where the activity under the license or permit is to be conducted;				
16	(c) the name of each person having who has an ownership interest in the business; and				
17	(d) the types of permits requested by the applicant.				
18	(2) The department shall, upon request, disclose:				
19	(a) public criminal justice information, as defined in 44-5-103, as required by 44-5-301;				
20	(b) all records and other information, except confidential criminal justice information, as defined in				
21	44-5-103, that relates to:				
22	(i) a sanction imposed under 23-5-136, for a violation of this chapter or a department rule; or				
23	(ii) any other civil or administrative sanction or penalty imposed under a provision of this chapter				
24	or a department rule for a violation of this chapter or a department rule.
